5. The school does not tolerate discrimination/prejudice against students on the basis of religion, economic status, caste, gender, locality, language, physical appearance or disability or any other factor.
6. All teaching, non-teaching and other staff are sensitive to the Child Protection Policy and the legislation relating to children.
7. All parents and students are made aware of the school's Child Protection Policy/Guidelines and reporting procedures.
8. The salient features or highlights of the school's Child Protection Policy are prominently displayed in the school premises visited by parents, children and visitors.
9. The school has a separate Child Protection notice board at a prominent location.
10. The school has children's forums/associations/clubs that encourage children's participation and provide a platform for them to discuss and share with teachers and authorities on safety, security and other related issues.
11. A suggestion/complaint box is provided to provide a space for children and parents to express their concerns or issues regarding child protection and safety.
12. The school maintains records of complaints brought by children to the S.O.A. or Child Protection Committee and these records are available for inspection.
13. The staff actively supervises students inside and outside the classroom.
14. Fire safety concepts are implemented in the school.
15. The entry of outsiders/visitors into the school building is controlled and monitored and the registration of visitors is strictly and diligently maintained by the security staff/administrative staff.
16. In case of family emergency or other emergency situations like unexpected closure, the school ensures that no child is allowed to leave the school premises unless the parent/guardian comes to pick the child up in person or an official letter is given by the parent/guardian. This information is provided to the parents/guardians.
17. The school maintains an updated list of parent/guardian contacts, address changes and emergency contact numbers for each student in the school.
18. Parents and guardians are connected to a messaging system or mobile networking and periodic information is sent to the parents.
19. Most teaching and non-teaching staff such as drivers, security and attendants are trained in communication and management of students with special needs, students using wheelchairs, students with cognitive, visual, speech or hearing impairments.
20. Students with special needs shall be accompanied only by an attendant or teacher while using the toilet.
21. Physical Education teachers shall be sensitive and shall involve students in sports according to their physical abilities and health-related problems.
22. No Physical Education teacher and other trainers shall be allowed to train any girl or boy in the sports room or any other secluded place, during or after school hours or during holidays, without the permission of the school authority and the parents/guardians.
23. The school shall provide an opportunity for all students to share their personal problems in confidence.
24. The school premises and classroom building shall not be used for storing other things.
25. The school prohibits all anti-social activities like gambling, drinking alcohol etc. in the school premises.
